D Russell who enlisted in the service of the  
United States, at Newark Pickering County  
Ohio on the seventh day of October 1864 as  
a private, in Company "F" commanded  
by Captain David R Hunt in the 25<sup>th</sup>  
Regiment of Ohio Vet Vol Infantry, in the  
war of 1861, and was honorably discharged  
on the sixth day of October 1865, that while  
in the service aforesaid and in the line of  
duty he contracted "Sciatic pain or Rheum-  
-atism of the hip" which disease was caused  
by exposure to cold and dampness, being  
quartered on damp ground at or near  
Charleston South Carolina. His residence  
since his discharge has been near Jonesville  
Muskingum County Ohio and he has  
been engaged in doing light work on a  
farm when able, but a large portion of  
the time on account of said disease, has

not been able to do any work at all  
He makes this declaration for the purpose  
of being placed on the invalid pension roll  
of the United States on account of the disabili-  
ty above mentioned. He further says that  
Captain Hunt under whom he served has  
removed to parts unknown to him although  
he has made various efforts to find him  
that he has no knowledge of the whereabouts  
of either of the Commissioned Officers who  
belonged to his company and he is  
therefore unable to procure a certificate of  
disability from either of them in support

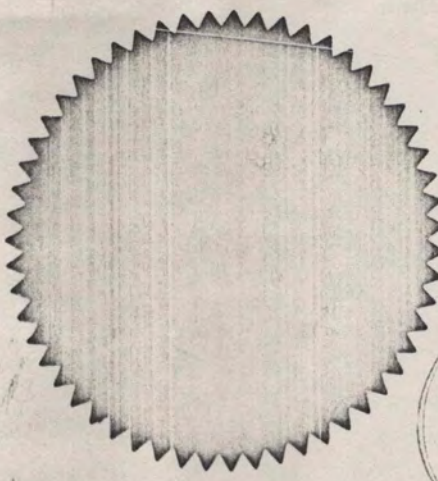

DECLARATION FOR WIDOW'S PENSION.

executed before a Court of Record or some officer thereof having custody of its seal, a Notary Public, or Justice of the Peace, whose official signature shall be verified by his official seal, and in case he has none, his signature and official character shall be certified by a Clerk of a Court of Record, or a City or County Clerk.

State of Ohio, County of Muskingum, ss:

On this 22 day of May, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and 11, personally appeared before me, E. G. Karm, within and for the County and State aforesaid, Catherine Russell, aged 68 years, a resident of Newton S. P. County of Muskingum, State of Ohio, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that she is the widow of John D. Russell, who enlisted under the name of John D. Russell, on the 24th day of October, A. D. 1864, as a Private in Company F, in the 25th Regiment of O. V. Infy. and served at least ninety days in the late War of the Rebellion, in the service of the United States, who was HONORABLY DISCHARGED October 11th 1865 and died May 17th 1911. That he was not employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated above and no other that stated above, and the dates at which it began and ended.

That he was never employed in the military or naval service of the United States after the 7th day of October, 1865. That she was married under the name of Catherine Turner to said John D. Russell on the 7th day of October, A. D. 1864, by Parley Suter J. P. at New Sonora O., there being no legal barrier to such marriage; that she had not been previously married; that her said husband had not been previously married.

(If either had been previously married, so state, and give date of death or divorce of former spouse.) That she has not remarried since the death of the said John D. Russell. That the names and dates of birth of all the children of the soldier, now living, and under sixteen years of age, are as follows:

That she has not abandoned the support of any one of her children, but that they are still under her care or maintenance. That no prior application for pension has been filed by herself or the soldier under No. 185-618.

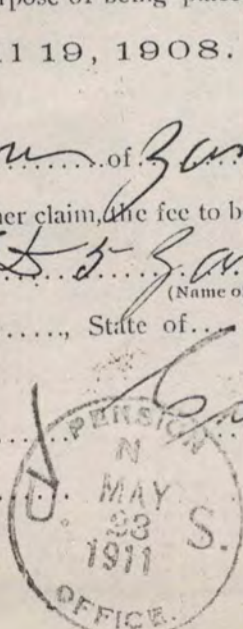

And I, John O. Russell do solemnly swear, that I will bear true faith and allegiance to the United States of America, and that I will serve them honestly and faithfully against all their enemies or opposers whomsoever; and that I will observe and obey the orders of the President of the United States, and the orders of the officers appointed over me, according to the Rules and Articles of War.
